- THE STUDENT HOUSE**
This bulding was built in 1903 as a hotel, which it remained until 1925. It then successively housed various shops. The house with its sandstone facade in the art nouveau style, has been listed by the Ministry of Culture.

- BUSINESSES**

The **weekly market** (food & flowers) takes place every Thursday morning in the square in front of the town hall from 7 am to 12 am. The **monthly market** is held on the first Thursday of the month and offers in addition a wide range of textiles, leather goods and household items.

- Regional cultural centre of Dudelange (CCRD) opderschmelz**
Jazz, pop, rock, folk, singing, world music, live theatre, literary and musical performances, theatre, dance, etc. It houses the town's cultural department and the regional music school.

HISTORIC BUILDINGS

- Castle of Mont-St-Jean**
The castle, dating from the 15th century, has been partly restored. A walk through the woods leads to the summit of Mont-St-Jean. Open all year. Free admission.

St. Martin's Church
The church is an example of the late 19th Century Gothic Revival style and is distinguished by its beautiful murals of early Christian and Byzantine inspiration and an immense organ. An organ festival of international renown is held each year at the church.

Town hall
The town hall (built in 1930) houses most of Dudelange's services (citizens' services, civil registrar, etc.). The Place de l'Hôtel de Ville, with its bandstand, hosts the market, various festivals and events.

#NATURE

- CIRCUIT DE LA RÉGION MINETTE**
10km hiking and mountain bike cross border route.
Start: Dudelange (Boulodrome, rue Reitschkopp)

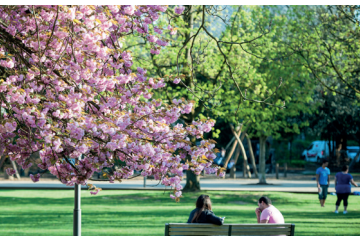
- HAARD NATURE RESERVE**
This protected nature reserve of 198 hectares offers several beautiful trails and paths. Numerous viewpoints provide opportunities to take spectacular photos of this former open cast mining area.

- ÉMILE MAYRISCH PARK**
Large green space in the heart of the city. It features water fountains, a large children's playground, petanque courts and a bar with terrace.

TOP 10 things to do

- #1 - FÊTE DE LA MUSIQUE**
Mid-June, this music festival offers a great variety of music styles on different stages and bars across the city. Entrance is free.

- #3 - FLOATER**

- #6 - DUDELANGE BY BIKE**

- #7 - INDOOR CLIMBING**
The climbing gym, with its 14.5 metre wall, is located in the René Hartmann sports centre and offers climbing for every level.

- #8 - NEED TO COOL OFF?**
During the summer the public outdoor swimming pool offers heated pools, a lawn for sunbathing, a beach volleyball court and a terrace.






















- #9 - CASTLE**
A short walk through the woods leads you to the ruins of the castle located on the summit of Mont-St-Jean. Free entrance.

- #10 - MEDIEVAL CHRISTMAS**
Dudelange is known for its Medieval themed Christmas market. It offers typical chalets and daily concerts, as well as animation in the Medieval village.
