#TRANSPORT

5 bus routes with stops every 250 metres. Lines 4 and 5 are regional lines connecting Dudelange to Esch-sur-Alzette. Line 507 connects Dudelange to Luxembourg-Kirchberg and line 631 connects Dudelange to Bettembourg. All the bus routes stop at the "Gare" (the closest stop to the student house).

HISTORIC BUILDINGS

Castle of Mont-St-Jean

The castle, dating from the 15th century, has been partly restored. A walk through the woods leads to the summit of Mont-St-Jean. Open all year. Free admission. Start: Place Gymnich, Dudelange-Boudersberg

The church is an example of the late 19th Century Gothic Revival style and is distinguished
