

The Fête de la Musique takes place in the heart of the city-center of Dudelange.

Arrival & departure

Please note that due to the number of visitors, there will only be limited parking around the festival. Here are your different options to get to the Fête de la Musique:

Rublic Transport

We highly recommend using public transport as parking will be limited in Dudelange and the surroundings. Public transport in Luxembourg is free throughout the whole country and for all different modes of transport such as busses, trams and trains. The best way to reach Dudelange by public transport is by train & bus. Plan your trip and find the fastest connections via **Mobiliteit.lu.**

P + Shuttle

The **P&R shuttle** will pick you up at the Cactus Bettembourg parking, at the industrial zone Wolser B, as well as at LNS and will drive you to Jean-Fohrmann-square. The P&R shuttle **runs every 30 minutes** and is **free of charge**. First trip at 6 pm. Returns every half hour starting at 6.15 pm. Last trip from Jean-Fohrmann-square at 3.15 am.
